Conduct of normal labor and delivery: physiology of labor, mechanism of normal labor, analgesia and anesthesia</li> <li>5. Medical and surgical illness during pregnancy and the puerperium</li> <li>6. Measurements of the gravid uterus</li> <li>7. Use of fetal monitoring (antepartum and intrapartum)</li> <li>8.
